Seminars & Workshops

Grades 3- 5

Introduction to Africa through Music and Dance:

Ancient history, geography, languages, ethnic groups, lifestyles, customs and tradition, art and wildlife. Live music and dance.

Recommended: 3 sessions (45 minutes each)

Grades 6- 8

Africa's Diverse Cultures and People:

Expansion of presentation for grades 3- 5 to include complexity of differences by regions. Live music and dance.

Recommended: 3 sessions (1 hour each)

Grades 9-12

African Politics, Economy and the role of UN in Africa:

Key developments in modern African politics including decolonization; the fight for independence and current problems of external trade and debt; effects of HIV/AIDS, famine and internal conflicts.

Recommended: 3 sessions (1 hour each)

Workshop for Teachers

Opportunity to attain a deeper knowledge and understanding of Africa's Beauty, Wonder & Diversity based on Ambassador Jalang'o's life experiences. Emphasis on using the study of Africa as a way to teach an appreciation of cultural diversity.

Recommended: 2 sessions (2½ hours each) OR, 1 intensive in house Session (3 hours)
